Parking & Entrance/Exit

There is a large car park area at the front of the school.

The pool is accessible through the entrance which can be seen to the left of the school entrance.

Please keep all of your belongings, including your removed shoes in a bag to maintain the cleanliness of the venue.

2 minutes before the end of the lesson, parents/guardians will be asked to wait in the correct changing room, children will be sent through once their lesson finishes.

Changing Facilities

Children using the changing facilities must be supervised. Children up to the age of 8 may go into the changing room with a parent/carer of the opposite gender.

These changing rooms must be left tidy at all times.

When entering, the first changing room is males and the second is females.

To access poolside, please enter the changing room, and use the door on the other side, this then connects to the corridor for poolside.

Important information

- During lessons parents/guardians must spectate from poolside quietly.
- Spectating is restricted to one parent per child to avoid overcrowding.
- Please ensure your child goes to the toilet before the start of their lesson.
- We have a strict no phones or electronic devices policy on poolside or in the changing areas to fall in line with our child protection policy.
- We have a photo week in the final week of each month at this venue, your teachers will inform and instruct you depending on wishes of other parents of what to do. Please do not take photos until instructed.
- To ensure lessons run safely and on time please bring your child onto poolside a couple of minutes before their lesson starts.

- When entering poolside, please remove your shoes and keep with your belongings.
- For health and safety reasons all swimmers with hair longer than shoulder length must wear a swim hat and we recommend all swimmers wear goggles (excluding those on the Parent & Child programme).
- For those attending our Parent & Child programme a well-fitting neoprene swim nappy must be worn as well as a disposable swim nappy.
- If you have any questions for teachers (unless it is urgent for the children's safety), please do not discuss any issues in between lessons. If you have any queries or concerns, please contact the office.
- If you are attending our Parent & Child programme, prams and car seats are not to be left on site during the lesson time.
- Prams and pushchairs must not be left in the changing rooms.
- If you are attending our Parent & Child programme, a responsible adult will be required to get into the water with your child during their lesson.
