Directions

Enter Shaw Hill Drive off the A6. Follow the road to the car park, please be aware this is a public access road with housing either side.

Entrance

Use the entrance to the leisure club opposite the hotel entrance.

On entering, please use the sign in sheet on your left.

Please shoe covers before entering the changing rooms.

Changing Facilities / Viewing area

There is no entry into the changing rooms until 10 minutes prior to your lesson start time.

Please bring your child swim ready, with swimwear underneath outdoor clothing.

The teacher will be in the pool, please only deliver your child to poolside 2 minutes before the start of your lesson.

The changing rooms must be left tidy at all times. No talcum powder use.

There is a strict one parent/guardian rule in place for spectating.

Parents/Guardians can spectate from poolside using the designated seating. Two minutes before the end of the lesson, please return to the changing areas where your children will follow when their lesson is complete.

Photography and Electronic device use

All mobile phone use is banned from poolside and changing rooms at all times. If you wish to use your mobile for personal use, please use it after the lesson outside the venue only.

Important information

No mobile phone or camera use

One guardian per child permitted

No outdoor footwear on poolside

Do not enter poolside until 2 minutes before

No food or drink except water

Guardians must stay onsite

No swimming unless your teacher is present

Ensure your child goes to the toilet before the start of their lesson.

For health and safety reasons all swimmers with hair longer than shoulder length must wear a swim hat and we recommend all swimmers wear goggles (excluding those on the Aqua Babies programme).

For those attending our Aqua Babies programme a well-fitting neoprene swim nappy must be worn as well as a disposable swim nappy.

If you have any questions for teachers (unless it is urgent for the children's safety), please do not discuss any issues in between lessons. If you have any queries or concerns, please contact the office.

If you are attending our Aqua Babies programme, a responsible adult will be required to get into the water with your child during their lesson.
